



Accommodation Options

To help you plan your time in Jerusalem this summer, below is information on some hotels that are in the vicinity of the Shalom Hartman Institute.

The Shalom Hartman Institute has arranged for discounted rates at several Jerusalem hotels if you wish to take advantage of them. Summer is a very busy period in Jerusalem, and there are a limited number of rooms available at each hotel. **The prices below are based on availability at the time of booking and rooms will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.** We recommend you make your reservation as soon as possible.

Please note that instructions differ for making reservations at each hotel. You must follow the instructions to get the discount (i.e. use corporate code when needed, or email the address provided indicating you are a Hartman participant). If you do not follow the instructions and commit to a higher rate, the hotel will not be able to refund the difference upon arrival.

Rates for all hotels are for foreign tourists and are exclusive of VAT.

As required by law, Israeli citizens will be charged 17% VAT.
